TERM TIME

Parents can opt for extended (7:30am - 6:00pm) or school day (8:40am - 3:45pm) options.

Many of our families choose our nursery and pre prep due to its academic rigour and reputation for supporting children to achieve excellent outcomes. Therefore, during the school term time our provision from 8:40am - 15:45pm will remain largely the same.

Extended day pupils arriving from 7:30am, will be treated to a nutritious breakfast, with a healthy and tasty variety of continental offerings, such as cereal, toast, fresh fruit and yoghurt. After 15:45pm, extended day pupils will enjoy activities such as 'outdoor explorers' 'reading friends' or 'numbots' in the later afternoon. These will be followed by a nutritious meal from around 16:30pm. The final hour of the day will provide pupils a chance to engage in free-flow play in their familiar class environment, with the supervising adults playing some games and reading somemstories too!

OUT OF TERM TIME

In the weeks when the main school is closed, the days will take on a slightly different character and we will enrich our provision with further child-led and active learning to consolidate term time topics.

This will include more play-based phonics and numeracy provision, as well as further opportunities to explore outdoors and to play. Breakfast, lunch and tea will still be served daily as in term time. The pupils will even get to do even more cooking of their own!

COSTS AND FUNDING

Children at Forest Park are able to benefit from Government funding schemes. If you qualify for funding, your child can become eligible for age specific the month after their relevant birthday.

2 - 3 Year Olds

If eligible, children can claim 15 hours funding from September 2024, which totals 570 hours per year.

This will increase to up to 30 hours funding from September 2025.

3-5 YEAR OLDS

After their third birthday, all families in England are eligible for a total of 570 hours per year that you can use flexibly (subject to T&C's).

Some families are eligible for a further 570 hours, and this can be used on a plan of 3 days or more per week.

TAX FREE CHILDCARE

Tax-free childcare can provide a significant saving for you each month and is available for all children of nursery school age. It can also be used alongside the above funding options.

Our nurseries are open for 48 weeks of the year. Therefore, the Government funding of 38 weeks of the year (term time), is stretched over the full opening period; 15 hours equates to 11.8 per week.
